Dear Sir or Madam,

This letter provides the status of the reactor vessel head inspections at San Onofre Unit 3 in light of the recently received order on this issue.

San Onofre Unit 3 is in the process of returning to power from its Cycle 12 refueling outage. Inspection of the reactor vessel head was completed in January 2003, during this refueling outage, in accordance with the commitments contained in our response to NRC Bulletin 2002-02 dated September 11, 2002 (Reference 1), as modified by our letter dated December 31, 2002 (Reference 2). The results of this inspection were discussed with the NRC staff in a telephone call on January 29, 2003.

On February 11, 2003, the NRC issued an immediately effective order establishing interim inspection requirements for reactor vessel heads at pressurized water reactors (Reference 3). By March 3, 2003, SCE will respond to this order in the context of the future inspections of the San Onofre Unit 2 and 3 reactor vessel heads at their next refueling outages.
