License Condition 48 of SUB-1010 requires the Sequoyah Fuels Corporation (SFC) to submit a reclamation plan on or before March 15, 2003. Enclosed with this letter is SFC's Reclamation Plan (RP) consistent with the guidance contained in NUREG 1620.

As you are aware, the State of Oklahoma and the Cherokee Nation have filed a hearing request on the recently approved by-product material possession amendment. SFC continues to discuss concerns that both parties have raised in an attempt to resolve their concerns and settle our differences outside the hearing process. SFC will keep you apprised of any agreements that we reach with the parties as the dialog continues.
