SUMMARY OF INFORMATION COLLECTION REQUEST

Title: Billing Instructions for NRC Cost Type Contracts

Current Burden/Responses: 1,851 hours/3,925 responses

Proposed Burden/Responses: 1,070 hours/2,140 responses

Frequency of Response: Monthly

Number of Respondents: 55

Reasons for Changes in Burden/Responses: The overall burden has decreased by 781 hours from 1,851 to 1,070 hours with a corresponding reduction in the number of responses from 3,925 to 2,140 responses because of a reduction in the number of active contracts and task orders. Accordingly, the billing burden (contracts and task orders) has decreased from 1,123 hours to 754 hours and the license fee recovery burden decreased from 728 hours to 316 hours due to the reduction in the number of active contracts and task orders. The overall impact is a decrease in burden and cost.
