ASSET OWNER – NMC RELATIONSHIP

The DAEC Emergency Plan was previously revised stating that the Asset Owner was IES. The name of the Asset Owner was changed to Interstate Power & Light Company via Amendment 244 to License DPR-49 for DAEC. As sections of the DAEC Emergency Plan are revised for other reasons, the following statement shall be incorporated into the applicable section. Until all sections are revised, this note shall suffice to ensure that the Asset Owner – NMC relationship is understood.

“The NMC is assigned operational responsibility for the DAEC. However, the Asset Owner maintains corporate accountability for activities at the DAEC and will participate when necessary in activities at the DAEC.
