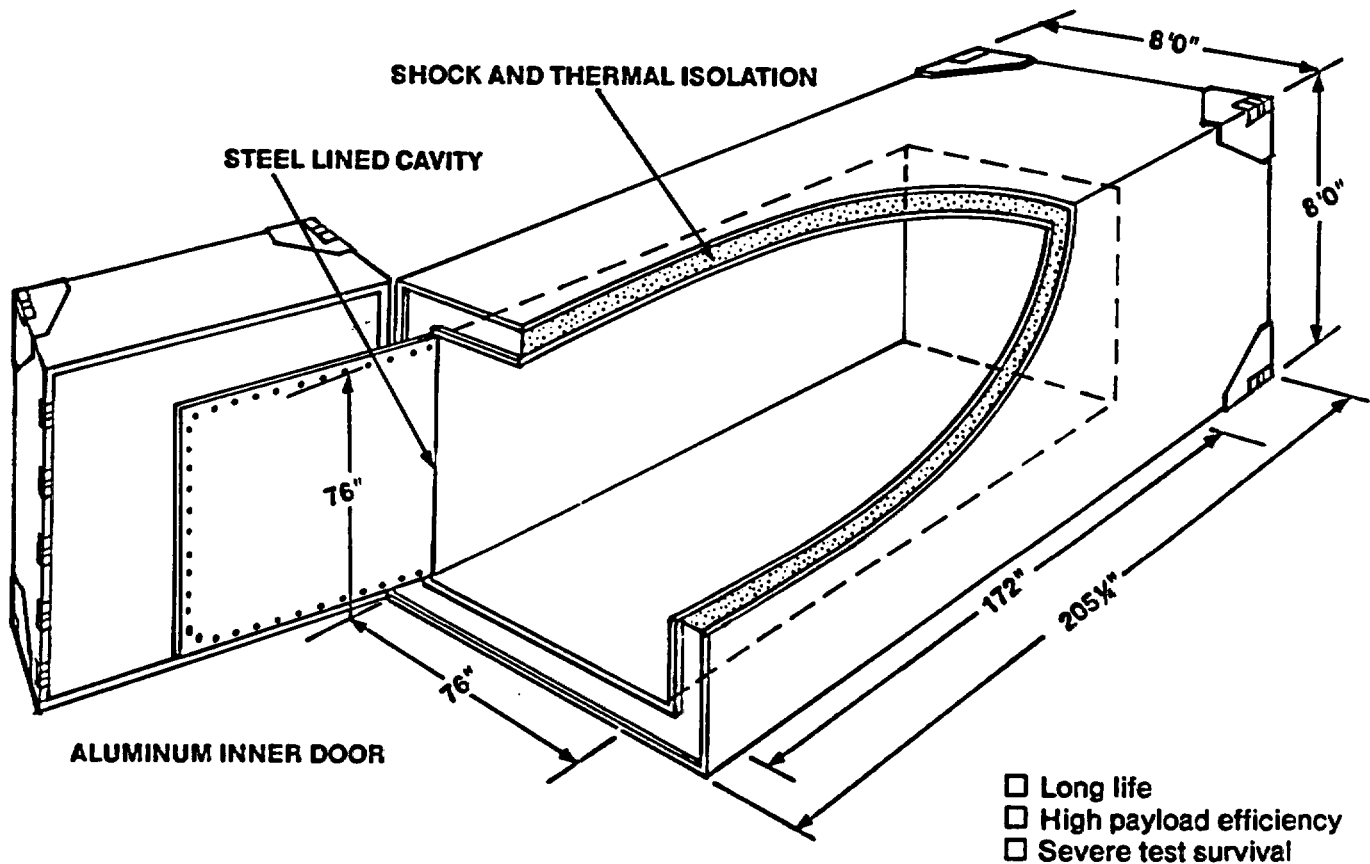

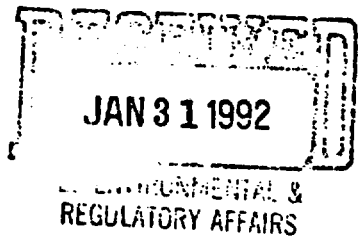

#### **OPERATING PROCEDURES AND MAINTENANCE PROGRAM**

The application for renewal does not provide information on operating procedures and a maintenance program for the Model No. 6400 package. The application should be revised to include specific sections on operating procedures and a maintenance program. These sections should provide, as a minimum the following information.

Operating procedures should address routine determinations given in 10 CFR §71.87. The procedures should address items such as inspections prior to loading, cautionary notes on package handling, limits on package contents, installation of a security seal, radiation and contamination surveys, and instructions pertinent to receiving and unloading the package. Operations should be listed sequentially in the order in which they are performed.

The maintenance program should describe the actions taken to ensure continued performance of the packaging. The program should include periodic testing, inspection, and replacement schedules, as well as criteria for replacement and repair of components.
