

WORK STATUS

We have received information, in the form of a draft report, from the Office of the Inspector General (OIG) regarding your possible misuse of TVA telephones, violation of time and attendance requirements, and other potential job-related misconduct. Although we have not reached a final decision with respect to these allegations, if true, they raise substantial questions about your truthfulness and reliability. Considering the seriousness of the issues and TVA's important obligations with respect to its nuclear program, I am placing you in a nonwork, pay status effective immediately pending my receipt and review of a final report from the OIG on your case. You will not have access to TVA's facilities or equipment during this period.

Our records do not indicate a home telephone or address for you and it is important that I be able to contact you on short notice. Accordingly, you must provide me a means (telephone number or pager number) in which to contact you. Additionally, you must be available in the event that I need to speak with you.
