TVA Exhibit 84 includes retention registers and memorandums notifying a number of Watts Bar employees that their positions are no longer needed and notifying them of their options to resign or to be assigned to TVAS. The memorandums generally had an effective date of October 1, 1996, and most were essentially the same as the notice given to Gary Fiser, Joint Exhibit 28. TVA Exhibit 84 includes more than 60 retention registers representing the same number of separate competitive levels which include more than 130 employees. Based on these retention registers, memorandums were issued to 38 employees giving them the option to resign or to be assigned to TVAS. Some of the employees who held bargaining unit positions were given a third option, the opportunity to exercise their right to reassignment to a previously held bargaining unit position. This option was not available to Mr. Fiser. The position he held was in the manager and specialist pay schedule, a position which is not in a represented bargaining unit. The exhibit also includes computer-generated retention registers with handwritten notes such as are described in TVA Exhibit 83.
