SUBJECT: TELECONFERENCE WITH NEI ON NFPA 805 RULE

On March 7, 2003, staff of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) held a teleconference with Fred Emerson, of the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) and Doug Brandes, of Duke Power, on actions for rulemaking for NFPA 805. Present for the NRC were Steven West, Eric Weiss, Paul Lain, Leon Whitney, and Joseph Birmingham. Steven West led the discussion for the NRC.

The NRC stated that it planned to not include the appendices of NFPA 805 within the rulemaking to allow NFPA 805. This was a change from wording in the Statement of Considerations for the proposed rule. The NRC recognized that methods such as those in the appendices would facilitate licensee implementation of NFPA 805 and that including such methods in the implementing guidance document being prepared by NEI was appropriate. Industry agreed and stated that it was their intention to include information on these methods in the implementing guidance to facilitate licensee implementation of NFPA 805. NRC said that it would review the information and, as appropriate, endorse it in a regulatory guide. There was further discussion on the types of methods and the detail that NEI would be able to support. NEI planned to include guidance on risk-informed circuit analysis, fire model application and fire probabilistic safety assessment application to the extent that current development allowed.

After discussing the above, the call was ended.
