**TVA Exhibit 110**

TVA Exhibit 110 contains more than 100 final and draft retention registers that show September 30, 1997, as the projected date of termination of about 175 Sequoyah employees. These registers, each of which reflects a separate competitive level, were used to determine which employees were surplus and should be assigned to TVAS or to CHR, if the employees did not find other TVA positions or offer to resign. The retention registers used an effective date of September 1997 since employees who were assigned to TVAS during Fiscal Year 1997 were assured that their employment would not be terminated before the end of September 1997. The notices to the individual employees whose positions were determined to be surplus are included in TVA Exhibits 96 and 109.
