TVA Exhibit 89 contains more than 135 retention registers that show September 30, 1997, as the projected date of termination of more than 135 Browns Ferry employees. These registers, each of which reflects a separate competitive level, were used to determine which employees to assign to TVAS or CTS as part of the 1996 reorganization of TVAN and are associated, in general, with the memorandums in TVA Exhibits 91 and 92 notifying employees of their option to resign or to be assigned to TVAS/CTS. The retention registers used an effective date of September 1997 since employees who were assigned to TVAS during Fiscal Year 1997 were assured that their employment would not be terminated before the end of September 1997.
