We have received the enclosed Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) letter, transmitting the FEMA final report dated December 11, 2002, for the September 24, 2002 radiological emergency preparedness plume pathway exercise at the Fermi Power Plant.

No deficiencies were identified during the exercise. However, two Areas Requiring Corrective Action (ARCAs) were identified.

We fully recognize that any corrective actions to be implemented may involve parties and political institutions which are not under your direct control. Nonetheless, we expect that assistance, if appropriate, will be extended.
