**SUBJECT: NOTIFICATION OF DISCONTINUATION OF REVIEW AND EVALUATION FOR
REGISTRATION OF MODELS SABRE CENTURION AND IONSCAN SENTINEL II**

Dear Ms. Ranger:

This letter is in response to your letter dated October 2, 2002, requesting the addition of Models Sabre Centurion and Ionscan Sentinel II to registration certificate no. NR-0163-D-101-G. In reviewing the letter, we find that it is lacking required information to conduct a safety evaluation. In the Enclosure to this letter, we have summarized the major issues not addressed in your request.

With incomplete documents and unavailability of adequate information, the NRC Staff is unable to complete a safety evaluation of your devices. Therefore, we have discontinued the review of the models. This is without prejudice to re-submission of your request. When you decide to re-submit your request, please ensure that you have included sufficient information to allow NRC to evaluate your devices. Please refer to NUREG-1556 Volume 3, Chapter 10 - Contents of the Application and the Review Process, and Appendix C - Application and Review Checklist.
