



This amendment relates to the construction and sale of bow sights containing tritium to TRUGLO, Inc. In addition, we are seeking to obtain documents that relate to the purchase orders and invoices involving the sales to TRUGLO, Inc. by 21st Century Technologies, Inc. The Plaintiff also seeks to obtain documents relating to the research and development of the bow sights that were sold to TRUGLO, Inc. by 21st Century Technologies, Inc. Moreover, the Plaintiff seeks the findings of the investigation conducted by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and the testimony of the witnesses who were deposed during the course of that investigation.


The information that Plaintiff seeks from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission is relevant to the issues in this dispute because copies of these documents were obtained from the defendant, 21st Century Technologies, Inc during the formal investigation that was conducted by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. The investigation related to the sale of bow sights to TRUGLO, Inc. by 21st Century Technologies, Inc. and possible violations of the defendant's materials license. The Plaintiff first became aware of these documents when she was interviewed by Special Agent Michael FitsGibbons of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.


