One more update based on a comment I got from Ken O'Brien (a DRS member of the SIT). It would be more accurate to update one of the risk assessment slides to read;

- •The recirculation orifices have been installed on a staggered basis.
- -U1 TDAFW Pump recirc orifice installed October 2002.
- -Both MDAFW Pumps recirc orifices installed in November 2001.
- -Unit 2 TDAFW Pump recirc orifice installed in May 2002.
- •Common Mode failure exposure time for Unit 1 is ~ 1 month. Common Mode failure exposure time Unit 2 is ~ 5 months.

This better portrays the time when the 3 AFWPs capable of feeding each Unit all had the recirc orifices installed that were susceptible to plugging. The previous numbers of 23 months etc, may convey a false sense of the common mode failure exposure time.
