Doug,

You missed the point. We already told you the date was no good. We are already working on getting a better date, with RES input. My point is that I can't put the TAC # in my TRIM without accepting the date. If you want me to use that TAC, change close date to 8/31/02, or I can't use it. To do so would be accepting the "pressure" that you acknowledge I am being put under. Besides, the proper date for closing this TAC is not the date that I issue a preliminary risk assessment. The process requires me to defend it in multiple venues over 90 day period.
