Title: Reports Concerning Possible Non-Routine Emergency Generic Problems

Current Burden/Responses: 53,260 hours/203 responses

Proposed Burden/Responses: 53,680 hours/204 responses

Frequency of Response: On-occasion

Number of Respondents: 204

Reasons for Changes in Burden/Responses: The estimated burden has increased by 420 hours because of an increase in the number of reactor licensee respondents from 103 to 104, to correct an error that was in the last extension clearance. The hourly cost rate increased from \$141 to \$156 per hour for reactor licensees and from \$140 to \$152 per hour for materials licensees.
