I am writing to comment on the Spent Fuel Transportation Package Performance Study Test Protocols (PPS). Because of geologic uncertainties that surround locating a permanent storage facility for nuclear waste at Yucca Mountain, waste casks must be guaranteed fool-proof. I would urge continued testing of storage casks, such that approved storage containers will survive--without question--repeated worst-case scenarios that result from both natural causes (e.g., earthquakes) and human error.
