Dear Mr. Christian:

By letter dated February 27, 2003, Virginia Electric and Power Company requested changes to the Operational Quality Assurance Program (Topical Report) for the North Anna and Surry Power Stations, Units 1 and 2, along with the ISFSIs at North Anna and Surry Power Stations. Your letter states that you have determined that the changes constitute a reduction in commitment to the QA program; therefore, these changes must be approved by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff prior to implementation in accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*, Section 50.54(a)(4).

As we discussed with Mr. Tom Shaub of your staff on March 25, 2003, we anticipate preparing a request for additional information, if necessary, by April 30, 2003, and we anticipate completing the review within 60 days after receiving your response.
