Eco-Pak Specialty Packaging (ESP), a division of The Columbian Boiler Company (CBC) requests that Certificate of Compliance No. USA/9234/B(U)F, Revision 11, for the NCI-21PF-1 overpack be transferred from Nuclear Containers, Inc. (NCI) to ESP. This overpack is used to ship 2½-ton cylinders of uranium hexafluoride by truck, ship and rail. CBC has purchased the assets of NCI, including the NCI-21PF-1 overpack, and has established ESP as a new division of CBC in its place.

ESP accepts responsibility for the completeness and accuracy of the statements and representations in the safety analysis report as supplemented for this package design.

ESP will be responsible for maintenance of the certificate, the safety analysis report for the package, and the existing quality assurance records in accordance with 10CFR71.91(c).

Records required by 10CFR71.91 for the package design are maintained at Eco-Pak Specialty Packaging in Elizabethton, Tennessee.
