The Division of Radiation Control (DRC) has received your letter, dated March 12, 2003, concerning a review of the proposed changes to R313-19-100, "Transportation" of the Utah Radiation Control Rules. I appreciate this review and I understand you have no comments.

You also summarized your knowledge of the status of other Utah rules on the State Regulation Status (SRS) Data Sheet and you asked that we let you know of our comments on the information contained in the SRS Data Sheet. Please be advised that we have identified the effective date and we have submitted a final copy of the changes needed for Regulation Action Tracking System (RATS) identification number 2000-2. Our process for addressing RATS #2000-2 was to incorporate, by reference, the requirements of 10 CFR Parts 34, 36, and 39 (2001 edition) into applicable sections of the Utah Radiation Control Rules. These incorporations have been correctly captured in the SRS Data Sheet for RATS identification numbers 1998-4, 1998-5, and 2000-1. After the SRS Data Sheet is revised, I would like another opportunity to review the data.
