NRC ASSIGNS NEW RESIDENT INSPECTOR TO MILLSTONE STATION

Nuclear Regulatory Commission officials in King of Prussia, Pa., have selected Kevin Mangan as a resident inspector at Millstone Station in Waterford, Conn. Mangan joins Senior Resident Inspector Max Schneider and Resident Inspectors Paul Cataldo and Silas Kennedy at the two-unit site. He succeeds Beth Sienel, who was reassigned to Vermont Yankee, in Vernon, Vt.

Mangan joined the NRC in 2001 as a region-based inspector in the Performance Evaluation Branch in the Region I Division of Reactor Safety. Prior to entering federal service, Mangan worked as a sales engineer for CW Sales Corporation in Norristown, Pa; in Emergency Services at PECO Energy Corporation, in Philadelphia; and, as an operations supervisor at the Portsmouth Uranium Enrichment Facility in Portsmouth, Oh. He served as a submarine officer in the United States Navy from 1988 to 1993.

Mangan has a Bachelor's of Science degree in civil engineering from Villanova University in Villanova, Pa.

Each U.S. commercial nuclear power plant has at least two NRC resident inspectors. They serve as the agency's eyes and ears at the facility, conducting regular inspections, monitoring significant work projects and interfacing with plant workers and the public.
