Energy Northwest gave an overview of how they were addressing the Davis-Besse issues, to include the development of a review team that identifies, reviews, screens and evaluates abnormal conditions. Energy Northwest also explained their integration of the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations' guidance into existing audit programs. The discussion continued with the AST submittal root cause evaluation. The staff emphasized that it was important to show results from the lessons-learned and to provide a quality product.
