## SYNOPSIS

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Office of Investigations, Region II, initiated this investigation on July 3, 2001, following a complaint by a former corporate information technology support manager for Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA), that he was the subject of employment discrimination by TVA management and terminated for raising concerns regarding the implementation of a new software program.

Based on evidence developed during this investigation, the allegation that a former corporate information technology support manager was the subject of employment discrimination for reporting quality concerns to TVA management associated with a new software program was not substantiated.
