SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO ORDER PROHIBITING INVOLVEMENT IN NRC-LICENSED
ACTIVITIES (NRC Office of Investigations Report No. 1-2001-031)

Dear Mr. Hinman:

This letter is in response to your email dated March 25, 2003, in which you consented to the conditions set forth in the Order dated February 28, 2003, but also asked that the Order be relaxed so that it only prohibits involvement in the management, oversight, or supervision of Byproduct Nuclear Materials activities. Your email indicates you plan to seek work in the commercial nuclear power industry as a job monitor or Quality Control Inspector. The Order does not prohibit you from working in the commercial nuclear power industry as long as you are not managing, or supervising NRC-licensed activities. Acting as a job monitor or Quality Control Inspector where you observe and report the quality of work is similar to the performance of radiography when you determine the quality of products. Therefore, performance of these jobs at a nuclear power plant is not prohibited by the Order.

If you decide to request actual relaxation from the terms of the Order in the future, please do so in an originally signed, written request.
