Subject: MODIFICATION NO. 2 TO TASK ORDER NO. 5, ENTITLED, "DEVELOPMENT OF STRATEGIES FOR PRIORITIZATION OF RESEARCH PROJECTS USING FORMAL DECISION METHODS " UNDER CONTRACT NO. NRC-04-01-067

In accordance with Section G.4, Task Order Procedures, of the subject contract, this letter definitizes Modification No. 2 to Task Order No. 5 which: (1) increases the ceiling amount of the task order by \$17,952.00 from \$86,962.80 to \$104,914.80; (2) increases the obligated amount of the task order by \$16,000.00 from \$86,962.80 to \$102,962.00, (3) extends the period of performance from "March 29, 2003" to "April 30, 2003" to allow the contractor to incorporate comments from NRC's management and the peer review into the draft NUREG/CR report, and issue it as a final report. The effective date of this modification is March 25, 2003. Therefore, any work performed during the period of February 1, 2003 through March 24, 2003 will not be reimbursed.; and (4) revises the deliverable date for the issuance of the Final Report to April 30, 2003 Accordingly, the task order is hereby revised as follows:

The second paragraph of the definitization letter of the basic task order is deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

"Task Order No. 5 shall be in effect from June 24, 2002 through April 30, 2003, with a cost ceiling of \$104,914.80. The amount of \$97,595.63 represents the total estimated reimbursable cost, and the amount of \$7,319.17 represents the fixed fee."
