SUBJECT: Comments on Proposed Rulemaking to 10 CFR Part 20, "Radiation Exposure Reports: Labeling Personal Information" (68 Fed. Reg. 14349, dated March 25, 2003)

This letter provides comments of the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI), on behalf of the nuclear energy industry, on the Nuclear Regulatory Commission proposal to revise 10 CFR Part 20, §20.2203, to require labeling, consistent with the Privacy Act of 1974, as amended, of personal information included in licensee reports of exposures, radiation levels, and concentrations of radioactive material exceeding the constraints or limits, as described in the subject *Federal Register* notice.

NEI has no significant adverse comments on the proposed rulemaking. However, we call your attention to the need to change the footnote citation in the proposed revision from "1," as shown in the subject *Federal Register* notice, to "7" in the final rule, to be consistent with the numbering scheme in 10 CFR Part 20.
