

The purpose of this modification is to:

- (1) revise subsection B.2 CONSIDERATION AND OBLIGATION paragraph (a) and (b) by:
 - (a) increasing the total estimated amount of the contract (ceiling) associated with potential overtime being worked by the contractor during the contract, by \$5,000.00 from \$93,392.00 to \$98,392.00;
 - (b) providing incremental funding which increases the contract-obligated amount by \$5,000.00 from \$45,000.00 to \$50,000.00;
- (2) revise Section B.3 DESCRIPTION/SPECIFICATIONS/WORK STATEMENT by: (a) under subsection 1 entitled BACKGROUND, paragraph four (4) change the approximate LTS activity from 40 to 50; and (b) under subsection 7 entitled REGION 1 DATA ENTRY DUTIES, change the approximate LTS activity from 40 to 50;
- (3) under Section C-Contract Clause, add contract clause 52.222-2 Payment for Overtime Premiums.

Accordingly, the following section of the contract is hereby modified:

1. Under subsection B.2 CONSIDERATION AND OBLIGATION, the first sentence of paragraph (a) and (b) are deleted entirely and the following is substituted in-lieu thereof:

"B.2 CONSIDERATION AND OBLIGATION

1. The total estimated amount of this contract (ceiling) for the products/services ordered, delivered, and accepted under this contract is \$98,392.00;
2. The amount presently obligated with respect to this contract is \$50,000.00;

- 2 Under Section B.3 DESCRIPTION/SPECIFICATIONS/WORK STATEMENT, subsections 1 entitled BACKGROUND, paragraph four (4) and subsection 7 entitled REGION 1 DATA ENTRY DUTIES, are changed as follows:

(a) subsection 1 entitled BACKGROUND, paragraph four (4) changes the approximate LTS activity from 40 to 50. Therefore, the paragraph would change as follows:

"LTS - LTS tracks the Nuclear Materials licensing activities. To do so, approximately 50 LTS worksheets milestones are submitted by the technical staff periodically to the Licensing Assistant Team (LAT) throughout the week. The data on the worksheets should be entered and proofread within 24 hours or less of receipt. Data can be proofread by querying what was entered."

(b) subsection 7 entitled REGION 1 DATA ENTRY DUTIES, change the approximate LTS activity from 40 to 50. Therefore, the paragraph would change as follows:

3. Section C-Contract Clause, is revised by adding contract clause C.18 52.222-2 Payment for Overtime Premiums. Therefore, the following clause is added:

"C.18 - 52.222-2 Payment for Overtime Premiums (July 1990).

(a) The use of overtime is authorized under this contract if the overtime premium does not exceed _\$5,000* or the overtime premium is paid for work- only authorized by the NRC PO in advance and

(1) Necessary to cope with emergencies such as those resulting from accidents, natural disasters, breakdowns of production equipment, or occasional production bottlenecks of a sporadic nature;

(2) By indirect-labor employees such as those performing duties in connection with administration, protection, transportation, maintenance, standby plant protection, operation of utilities, or accounting;

(3) To perform tests, industrial processes, laboratory procedures, loading or unloading of transportation conveyances, and operations in flight or afloat that are continuous in nature and cannot reasonably be interrupted or completed otherwise; or

(4) That will result in lower overall costs to the Government.

(b) Any request for estimated overtime premiums that exceeds the amount specified above shall include all estimated overtime for contract completion and shall-

(1) Identify the work unit; e.g., department or section in which the requested overtime will be used, together with present workload, staffing, and other data of the affected unit sufficient to permit the Contracting Officer to evaluate the necessity for the overtime;

(2) Demonstrate the effect that denial of the request will have on the contract delivery or performance schedule;

(3) Identify the extent to which approval of overtime would affect the performance or payments in connection with other Government contracts, together with identification of each affected contract; and

(4) Provide reasons why the required work cannot be performed by using multishift operations or by employing additional personnel.
