## Dear Ms. Hwang:

In accordance with the task order procedures of the subject contract, this letter definitizes Modification No. 14 to Task Order No. 1, to provide for Contractor's performance of the efforts described in the attached Statement of Work. As a result, the cost ceiling for Task Order No. 1 is increased by \$115,725.00 from \$1,245,861.33 to \$1,361,586.33. The sum of \$1,272,511.11 represents the reimbursable costs and the sum \$89,075.22 represents the fixed fee.

The Period of Performance for Task Order No. 1 is hereby extended through March 02, 2004.

This Modification No. 14 does not obligate additional funds.

FY 01 Obligated Amount: \$ 471,000.00
FY 02 Obligated Amount: \$ 432,000.00

Cumulative Total of NRC Obligations: \$1,168,000.00

The obligated amount shall, at no time, exceed the task order ceiling. When and if the amount(s) paid and payable to the Contractor hereunder shall equal the obligated amount, the Contractor shall not be obligated to continue performance of the work unless and until the Contracting Officer shall increase the amount obligated with respect to this task order. Any work undertaken by the Contractor in excess of the obligated amount specified above is done so at the Contractor's sole risk.

The Contractor agrees that such personnel shall not be removed from the effort under the task order without compliance with Contract Clause H.5, Key Personnel.
