Purpose:


On July 29, 1983, the NRC sent a letter to each non-licensee company that received apparently fraudulent material from Ray Miller, Inc., asking the company to identify nuclear facilities that may have been supplied fraudulent material. They were also asked to identify the customer to whom they sold the material if they themselves were not the end-user. A second letter was sent on September 21 to those companies that had not yet responded. As of the date of the first supplement to IEB 83-07, 65 percent of the companies had responded. As of the date of this supplement, an additional 12 percent have responded. We believe the responses to these letters to be essentially complete. Attachments 1 through 3 identify additional respondents identified as end-users, secondary recipients, and NRC licensees identified as secondary recipients.
