Paragraph 2.1 of the same revision states in part, "The person responsible for directing and managing the overall NNWSI Project Participant QA program shall be identified and have appropriate organizational position, responsibilities, and authority to exercise proper control over the QA program."

Note: As interpreted by the Project Quality Assurance office the QA program includes the individuals directly performing functions of verifying adequacy and effectiveness of the SNL QA program requirements.

Officer. Furthermore, there was no QA Organizational Chart that delineates the reporting relationship between the QA Coordinator and QA personnel. It should be noted that during the audit there was no objective evidence found which would indicate that the above reporting relationship has had an adverse impact on the SNL QA program.

As contract monitor for the QA support services contract, the QA Coordinator has the same relationship with contractor employees performing QA functions. However, as is indicated in block 9, above, these relationships are not clearly delineated in writing. Therefore, SNL will issue a QA Advisory to all staff personnel to clarify any misunderstanding that may exist and will submit a request for Project Office approval of a revision to the SNL QAPP to clearly delineate the position, responsibilities, and authority that already exists. Add the following text for block 14, following, "... providing direction, etc.).": "As is the case for all Task Leaders, those staff personnel report to the QA Coordinator for activities within that WBS element." Also, add the following text at the end of block 14 after, "... that already exists," and before, "Responsible Party": Additionally, to provide appropriate authority to exercise proper control over the QA Program, the QA coordinator will perform performance appraisal for SNL QA personnel and provide that appraisal to the Director, Nuclear Waste Management and Transportation. This authority will be included in the revision to the QAPP mentioned above."

Change block 15 to read: "2-16-90."

The supervisor of this division reports to the Department Manager, who is the SNL Technical Project Officer, and as such reports to a management level higher than the line management personnel responsible for performing activities affecting quality. Additionally, the QA Division Supervisor manages and supervises the activities of QA staff personnel and contractor personnel within the division. As such, the QA Division Supervisor has appropriate organizational position, responsibilities, and authority to exercise proper control over the QA Program.
