

NRC Inspection Report 50-334/03-006 & 50-412/03-006 documented a preliminary white finding concerning the ability to ensure timely augmentation of the emergency response organization with 12 radiation protection technician positions. FirstEnergy Nuclear Operating Company (FENOC) requests that a regulatory conference be held to provide the NRC with the results of our investigation of this issue, including the root cause, the corrective actions that are being taken and safety significance. A regulatory conference will be scheduled with Mr. Richard Conte.
