EVENT TEXT

OFFSITE NOTIFICATION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

An immature green sea turtle was rescued from the plant's intake canal. The turtle is alive but in need of rehabilitation. As required by the plant's sea turtle permit, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (Florida Fish and Wildlife) was notified of this event.
