Subject: Old Farley LPDR

Today I received a call from Bettye Forbus, Director, Houston-Love Memorial Library, Dothan, AL. Bettye informed me that a man who said he was Mr. Donnie Hardy, Document Control Supervisor, Joseph M. Farley Nuclear Plant, called her and said he was coming to the library with a truck to remove the Farley document collection, paper and microfiche both. He told her there was information in the collection that they do not want available. She said he even asked about the microfiche cabinets the microfiche is stored in.

Bettye decided to call me since she was sure if NRC was having all the old LPDR collections pulled from the libraries we would have called her. I told her I was not aware of any effort to pull the document collections. She confirmed that her library is not under GPO. I told her that NRC relinquished ownership rights to the collection, equipment and cabinets to the Houston-Memorial Library and that it was now up to the library whether they wanted to let this man take the collection or not. Bettye said she just didn't feel comfortable letting him take the collection, that she really wasn't sure he was actually who he said he was since the only phone number he gave her was a cell phone number. She said she may try to contact the utility to confirm who he is. I did make a suggestion that if she does not feel comfortable giving him the collection, which she realizes will most likely never be returned, she could offer to remove it from public access. Bettye said that is probably what she will do. She said if she has any other concerns she may call me back. I told her that was fine.
