Enclosed with this letter is a controlled copy of Study Plan 8.3.1.17.4.12, Revision 0 (enclosure 1) prepared by the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) for the Yucca Mountain Nevada site. The study plan numbers correspond to the same numbers used in the Site Characterization Plan (SCP) for the Yucca Mountain site.

Study plans are prepared, reviewed, and approved under Yucca Mountain Site Characterization Office quality assurance procedures. It should be noted that there may be some inconsistencies in the milestone report titles and schedules given in this study plan and those in the SCP. Study plans, in general, represent a further evolution of the study in the areas related to schedules and milestones relative to the SCP, and as such, represent DOE's current plans.

DOE has reviewed the study plan for consistency with the content requirements for study plans, as given in Attachment 1 to the 1993 DOE/U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Level of Detail agreement and review process for study plans. No technical procedures will be used in conjunction with this study plan; all work will be documented in scientific notebooks.

DOE did identify Site Characterization Analysis (SCA) open items related to this study plan. Enclosure 2 is a summary of how this study plan addresses SCA open comments 8, 68, 69, 75 and Question 1.
