EVALUATION OF RESPONSE TO CORRECTIVE ACTION REQUEST (CAR) YM-92-008 RESULTING FROM YUCCA MOUNTAIN QUALITY ASSURANCE DIVISION (YMQAD) AUDIT YMP-91-I-01 OF YUCCA MOUNTAIN SITE CHARACTERIZATION PROJECT OFFICE

The YMQAD staff has evaluated the response to CAR YM-92-008. The response has been determined to be unsatisfactory based on the following:

- 1. Remedial action to correct the identified condition is not addressed as required by Quality Assurance Administrative Procedure (AP) 16.1, Corrective Action, Revision 4, paragraph 6.1.7.
- 2. In recapitulation of this CAR, AP 5.32Q, Test Planning and Implementation Requirements, Revision 1, Step 18, requires, as part of the minimum information to be included in the test planning packages, "documentation of completion of prerequisites." Contrary to this requirement, test plans Technical Program Plan (TPP) 91-32 and TPP 91-34 are silent on prerequisites. Omission is clearly a deficiency, even if no prerequisites were specified by the Division Directors/Technical Project Officers, per Step 10 of AP 5.32Q, Revision 1. If prerequisites are not specified, the test plan must provide objective evidence of that fact.
- 3. With regard to Part 3 of the response, the revision of AP 5.32Q will be examined to determine whether the deficiency will recur.

An amended response is required to be submitted to this office within ten working days of the date of this letter. Please ensure that the amended response includes an estimated completion date for the remedial action. Send the original of your response to Nita Brogan, Science Applications

## CORRECTIVE ACTION REQUEST (continuation sheet)

This CAR recommends 3 actions: 1. Correct discrepancies identified,
2. Investigate to determine if similar discrepancies exist, and 3. Take
action to resolve recurrence such as changing AP 5.32Q.

The responses to these 3 recommendations are:

- The lack of prerequisites in TPP 91-32 and TPP 91-34 is due to there being no TPP prerequisites. This has been confirmed by Forrest Peters and Marvin Saines respectively. A review of the documentation indicates that the procedure was followed, and since there were no prerequisites, there were no discrepancies.
- 2. Investigation of other TPP's, existing or in process 90-1, 91-2, 92-01, and the yet to be numbered TPP for UZ-16, indicates that "prerequisite requirements" for the TPP's do not exist or are being considered. Prerequisites for the Job Packages themselves are handled under AP 5.210.
- 3. To better insure that all required activities are identified and accounted for, AP 5.32Q has been revised (Rev 2, ICN 1), approved by QA, and released.
