Entergy Nuclear Potomac, a subsidiary of Entergy Nuclear Inc., is currently preparing an Early Site Permit (ESP) application for the site on which Grand Gulf Nuclear Station is located.

Entergy intends to submit its ESP application mid to late July, 2003. This schedule change is due to the delayed completion of seismic analysis for the application. In order to provide sufficient time for its final application reviews, Entergy has decided to delay submittal of the application by a few weeks beyond the date previously reported to the NRC.
