1: Corrective Action Response for CAR YM-92-018

- A. Remedial Action - LLNL will review Audit reports for Audits 91-02, 91-10, 91-14, and 91-15. All comments, recommendations and observations noted will be evaluated against the definition of adverse findings.

- B. Investigative Action - To determine the extent of this condition, LLNL will extend the review to cover all LLNL YMP internal and external audit reports generated as a result of audits performed between June 1991 and December 1991. All comments, recommendations, and observations noted will be evaluated against the definition of adverse finding.

- C. Root Cause Determination - This condition was first noted during the YMPO Audit of the LLNL YMP QA Program in June 1991. A CAR was issued (CAR YM-91-060) at that time. Considerable dialogue ensued between LLNL and YMPO concerning appropriate measures to be taken to close this CAR. Additionally an internal audit at LLNL pointed out that variations in definitions between the QP and the QP Manual Tab C allowed considerable leeway on the part of the individual auditor in making a determination of appropriate documentation of audit concerns. A final response to the CAR was accepted by YMPO in October 1991. The corrective action resulted in a change to the QP and elimination of definitions in the QP, eliminating alternative definitions in the QP and referring auditors back to definitions in Tab C.

- D. Corrective Action to Preclude Recurrence - QP 18.0, Rev. 3 and QP 18.1, Rev. 3 were issued for implementation on 11/1/91. Implementation of these procedures for future audits is expected to fully preclude recurrence of the noted condition. Change Notice C-2-1 was issued for implementation on 12/5/91. This Change Notice further clarified the definition of Adverse Finding.

- C. Variations in definitions listed in Procedures/QP Manual, permitted considerable leeway in determinations of deficiencies.

CORRECTIVE ACTION:

- D. Revision to QP 18.0, Revision 3, and QP 18.1, Revision 3, 11/1/91, deleted definitions for potential findings. C/N C-2-1 was issued against the QP Manual (12/5/91) to re-define the definitions of "Adverse Findings." All definitions are now in Section "C" of the QP Manual.
