The Environment & Public Health Panel of the NWTRB will hold a public hearing on Monday, October 15, 1990, at the Peppermill Hotel, 2707 South Virginia Street, Reno, Nevada, from 1:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. Interested persons are encouraged to attend and comment on issues pertaining to the potential effects on the environment and public health of siting a permanent repository for spent fuel and defense high-level waste at the proposed Yucca Mountain Site in Nevada. You may participate in three ways:

Formal testimony

• Those wishing to present formal testimony must submit a request to the NWTRB's Director of External Affairs by close of business, September 25, 1990. Include the following information:

- (1) name of person testifying,
- (2) title, if any,
- (3) name of organization, if any,
- (4) telephone number, and
- (5) length of time desired for the presentation (the time allowed for each statement will depend on the number of people wishing to testify. You will be informed of the time allotted soon after the September 25 deadline).

(If a contact person is listed, please provide the same information for that person.)

- Submit 10 copies of testimony and any accompanying slides or other documentation to the NWTRB for distribution to Board members by no later than October 8, 1990.
- Bring 50 additional copies to the hearing for distribution to the audience.

Walk-in, informal testimony

• Sign up on the day of the hearing at the Peppermill Hotel (702-826-2121) beginning at 1:00 P.M. Time slots will be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis.

Statements for the record

• Anyone may submit written comments in lieu of appearing before the members of the panel until November 30, 1990. Submit original copy to Chair, E&PH Panel, NWTRB, 1100 Wilson Blvd., Suite 910, Arlington, Virginia, 22209.

All participants should be prepared to answer questions from Board members. Transcripts of the hearing will be made.
