The Environmental and Public Health Panel of the Nuclear Waste Technical Review Board will hold a public hearing on Monday, October 15, 1990, from 1:00 P.M. - 8:00 P.M. The purpose of the hearing is to obtain the views of the public on issues under study by the Board as part of its review of the Department of Energy's (DOE) program to develop and site a permanent repository for the disposal of spent nuclear fuel and high-level radioactive waste.

The following day, Tuesday, October 16, 1990, from 8:30 A.M. - 12:00 noon, the DOE will provide panel members with a brief update on the Department's environmental overview program pertaining to the Yucca Mountain Site, and a description of the Department's socioeconomic program. Representatives of the Western Shoshone National Council, and Clark, Lincoln and Nye Counties have been invited to make comments on the plan after the DOE presentation.

Both meetings will be held at the Peppermill Hotel, 2707 South Virginia Street, Reno, Nevada 89502. Individuals desiring to attend may make reservations by calling (702) 826-2121. A block of rooms has been reserved with a government rate of \$44. Reservations should be made by September 21, 1990, and those calling must identify they are attending the NWTRB meetings to be included in the room block.
