# I. CRITICAL ITEM STATUS - YUCCA MOUNTAIN SITE CHARACTERIZATION PROJECT (YMP)

# A. Site Characterization Planning

Revision 4.01 of the Midway Valley activities time-phased logic network was issued on January 23, 1991. The Readiness Review Decision Notice prepared by the Readiness Review Board Chairman was transmitted on January 18, 1991. All prerequisites to begin trenching in Midway Valley have been completed except for the issuance of air quality permits by the State of Nevada and notification of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on the closure of the audit recommendations.

Management review of drawings and specifications for the deepening of Trench 14 is scheduled to begin on January 29, 1991.

#### Site Characterization Plan (SCP) Progress Report

The final draft of the third semiannual, "Progress Report on Site Characterization: Yucca Mountain, Nevada" (SPR 3), for the period April through September 1990 is currently undergoing concurrence review at the U.S. Department of Energy/Headquarters (DOE/HQ). Upon completion of this review, the Yucca Mountain Site Characterization Project Office (YMPO) will finalize a camera-ready copy of SPR 3 for submittal for printing.

#### SCP Comments

The transcript from the YMP Update Meetings held in November 1990 at Henderson, Amargosa Valley, and Hawthorne, Nevada, was evaluated for potential impacts on the site characterization program. Individual comments were identified and categorized from the transcript, cross-reference was made to applicable SCP sections, and technical staff determined whether any new concerns are expressed in these comments that would not be addressed as part of the baselined site characterization program.

No significant items reported this week.

#### Testing Prioritization Task (TPT)

Core Team members continued to compile and draft various sections of the Phase 1 final report.

Minutes were issued for the assessment meeting of the Integration Team which was held on January 18-19, 1991, in Las Vegas, Nevada.

A Core Team meeting was held in Las Vegas, Nevada, on January 24-25, 1991.

Support was provided for the Advisory Committee on Nuclear Waste (ACNW) Meeting held in Washington, D.C.

# B. Environmental Programs

### Environmental Compliance and Permitting

The Hazardous Materials Management Program is implemented. Requests to use regulated materials are being reviewed and approved, and approval letters are being sent to the requesting organization.

DOE/HQ gave approval to publish the Floodplain/Wetlands Assessment.

Environmental Training Program improvements are being made.

Preactivity surveys continue.

#### Environmental Field Programs

The Radiological Monitoring Program was restarted. This startup included continuous air samplers, radon monitors, ambient radiation monitors, a ground survey of the Midway Valley A prime trench area, and soil samples—

Text was prepared for the Programmatic Agreement Annual Report to the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation.

Monitoring continued on 12 radio-marked tortoises. In addition, the desert tortoise winter burrows were measured as part of the habitat use and movements study.

Data analysis was initiated on small mammal trap data.

#### C. Field Operations

Submitted BTP-SMF-005 to Plans and Procedures Division for Quality Management Procedure 06-04 review.

Prepared specimens for Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory. We are now awaiting approval from the director of the Regulatory & Site Evaluation Division.

### D. Project Planning and Control

Fiscal year 1991 account updates from participants continue. Data is being input into Planning and Control Systems (PACS). Current data has been received from Technical and Management Support Services (T&MSS), MAC Technical Services Company (MACTEC), Reynolds Electrical & Engineering, Co., Inc. (REECo), Raytheon Services Nevada (RSN), Sandia National Laboratories (SNL), and partial data from Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL).

Received December 1990 performance data (actuals) from T&MSS, MACTEC, REECo, RSN, USGS, LANL and SNL and input the data into PACS. Produced performance reports and distributed them to participants and the YMPO.

### E. Quality Assurance (QA) Implementation

The QA staff hosted a Software QA Workshop on January 22-23, 1991. The workshop provided a forum for participants to discuss software issues and requirements.

# F. Major Oversight Group Meetings

Carl Gertz, DOE Project Manager, participated in State of the Project Meetings at SNL on January 24, 1991, and at LANL on January 25, 1991.

# G. Public Outreach Activities

Project staff reviewed the draft education plan currently being developed for grades seven through nine.

### H. Near Term Decision Plan

No significant change in milestone status from the last Program Management Meeting.

#### II. ANALYSIS & VERIFICATION DIVISION

Attended presentations on the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP) performance assessment activities in Germantown, Maryland, on January 23, 1991, and a presentation on the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency on January 24, 1991, in Washington, D.C.

Attended an ACNW meeting on January 24, 1991, which primarily concerned human intrusion. Attended a meeting on expert judgment held on January 25, 1991.

#### III. SIGNIFICANT ACCOMPLISHMENTS/INFORMATION ITEMS

Project staff began preparations and arrangements for the Edison Electric Institute visit scheduled for February 12-14, 1991.

A Repository Plan workshop was conducted on January 24, 1991. The scope of the workshop included review of the "consultative draft" and an evaluation of options for the completion of the baseline Repository Plan (RP). Discussions included delaying of RW-1 Milestone, RYM05

(currently set at March 1, 1991), to await the results of the Management System Improvement Strategy (MSIS). These results could significantly impact the following elements of the RP: (1) objectives and mission needs; (2) technical strategy and approach; (3) risk assessment; (4) management approach; and (5) project schedule and resources.

A tentative agreement has been reached by the OGD and Office of Systems and Compliance that allows the YMP to proceed with development of the ESF design requirements documents and design activities in parallel with development of MSIS documentation. It is expected that ESF design will include the following: the Basis for Design Document, General Arrangements Drawings, the Design Summary Report, and the Associated Technical Reviews.

YMPO support for the MSIS included the following:

- The Functional Analysis working group completed its initial activities in Las Vegas, Nevada, on January 17, 1991.
- \$202,478 of \$600,000 budgeted has been spent by the YMP as of close of business January 18, 1991.
- The Programmatic Task Force is completing its report, "Configure System," in Richland, Washington. The Physical Systems Task Force is compiling data on the "Dispose Waste" function in Washington, D.C.
- The next MSIS Programmatic Task Force meeting to be supported by the YMP is scheduled for the week of February 4, 1991, in Washington, D.C.

The Nuclear Waste Technical Review Board (NWTRB) has concurred with DOE's proposed agenda for the Engineered Barrier System Concepts Workshop tentatively scheduled for June 18-20, 1991. The workshop will be chaired by an independent facilitator and will include an expert panel.

A field trip to the Yucca Mountain site area is scheduled for January 29-30, 1991, for six members of the seventeen-member National Academy of Sciences Coupled Processes Panel reviewing the 1989 Szymanski Report. This trip was arranged by YMPO for those members of the panel who were unable to attend the full panel field trip in October 1990.

# I. CRITICAL ITEM STATUS - YUCCA MOUNTAIN SITE CHARACTERIZATION PROJECT (YMP)

# A. Site Characterization Planning

#### Midway Valley Trenching

Revision 4.02 of the Trench 14 activities time-phased logic network was issued on January 30, 1991. No schedule slippage has been identified.

Management review of drawings and specifications for the deepening of Trench 14 is in progress.

The Midway Valley Readiness Review Record Memorandum was finalized this week and the records package will be submitted to the Local Records Center.

All activities associated with trenching remain in place ready to commence work. Subsequent reports will not contain weekly status of Midway Valley-Calcite Silica planning.

#### Site Characterization Plan (SCP) Progress Report

#### Comments

A three-day Integration Group Meeting is being held in Las Vegas, Nevada, to develop draft responses to the Nuclear Waste Technical Review Board's (NWTRB) recommendations in their Second Report to the U.S. Congress, and to continue response development for the State of Nevada's September 1989 comment package on the SCP.

#### SCP Study Plan Status

A draft of Study Plan 8.3.1.2.2.9, "Site Unsaturated-Zone Modeling and Synthesis," was received for review from the U.S. Geological Survey.

Study Plan 8.3.1.15.1.1, "Laboratory Thermal Properties," was transmitted to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for review by the U.S. Department of Energy/Headquarters (DOE/HQ) on January 25, 1991.

Study Plan 8.3.1.2.3.1.1-6, "Characterization of Site Saturated-Zone Ground-Water Flow System," was approved by the Regulatory and Site Evaluation Division Director and Yucca Mountain Quality Assurance Division Director and is ready for controlled distribution.

### C. Field Operations

Training classes were conducted at the Field Operations Center. These classes included Site Orientation and Environmental Awareness, and Yucca Mountain Safety & Health Training.

The Site Manager is reviewing the two Notices-to-Proceed issued by the Yucca Mountain Site Characterization Project Office (YMPO) for Job Packages 91-1, Midway Valley, and 91-4, Environmental Field Activities.

Participants are collecting relevant supportive data. The group will reconvene on February 4-6, 1991, to develop recommendations for improving the Software QA requirements. Recommendations will be presented to DOE management on February 7, 1991.

YMP personnel involved in the first QA Workshop to identify scientific issues/problems with the QA Program are finalizing their presentation, which is to be given to John Bartlett, Director, OCRWM, Frank Peters, Deputy Director, OCRWM, and Carl Gertz, Project Manager, DOE/YMPO, on February 8, 1991.

The YMPO QA issued a letter to Dwight Shelor, Associate Director, Office of Systems and Compliance, for transmittal to the NRC on acceptability of the QA Program for the start of Midway Valley/Calcite Silica activities.
