The records package for the specific report cited in Block 6 of this CAR will be evaluated/corrected by 5/29/92. In addition, record packages identified during investigative actions noted in item B. below will be evaluated/corrected by 8/3/92.

Investigative Action - Actions taken to determine the extent of the condition. В.

Investigative actions taken by Hydrologic Investigations Program (HIP) have identified 25 additional report record packages in the YMP-USGS Local Records Center that require further evaluation and identification of possible need for remedial action.

Initial investigative actions have not identified that the same deficiency exists with Geologic Division/Geologic Studies Program report record packages. Therefore, approximately 50 records packages will be randomly sampled by the Branch Office. A supplemental response will be forwarded to DOE/YMQAD by 6/8/92 to outline the results of the investigation and, if needed, to identify required remedial actions to be completed by 8/3/92.

VERIFICATION OF CAR NO. YM-92-029

Verification of CAR YM-92-029 was performed during Audit YMP-92-20 and on September 15, 1992.

REMEDIAL:

- Investigative action by the YMP-USGS identified 25 additional report record packages in the YMP-LRC that required further evaluation.
- 2. In addition, 50 Geologic Division/Geologic Studies Program report record packages were evaluated. Included in the packages were major comment made by reviewers.
- The QAR reveiwed 2 packages at the YMP-USGS LRC. "Absorption of Water into Porous Blocks 3. of Various Shapes and Sizes: Water Resources Research," and Preliminary Permeability and Water-retention Data from Non-welded and Bedded Tuff Samples, Yucca Mountain Area, Nye County, Nevada." The Technical Reviewer's Appraisal Forms for both reports were marked "Publish with minor technical revision (as noted below or in attached memorandum)." Upon review of comments to both reports, the QAR concurred that the comments were minor or editorial in nature.

Upon further investigation, YMP-USGS determined that 2 reviews by A.K. Turner had been withheld from the original report record package. These were submitted to the YMP-USGS LRC as an amendment to the original package on August 3, 1992.
