<p>Summary:</p> <p>Item 10 (waste management) of licensee's revised application renewal application did not meet the NRC guidelines. I called Richard to obtain clarification about this item. He stated that the irradiated components that they receive come with list of radioactive isotopes present in the components.</p> <p>I told him that only those isotopes with half-life less than 120 days may be stored for decay in storage. Longer-lived isotopes must be disposed of as radioactive waste. He stated that he will revise this item and fax the revised version of their waste disposal procedure.</p>
