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⁹BASIS OF EVALUATION/DESCRIPTION OF OBSERVATIONS:

- (1) Ashcroft Temperature Probe Gauge PTL No. W5765 was located and viewed to determine that the correct hold tag was still attached and that it was not in use. The Reynolds Electrical and Engineering Company, Inc. (REECo) Calibration Foreman stated that the gauge will be held at the calibration laboratory until retesting can be scheduled.
- (2) Raytheon Services Nevada (RSN) and REECo Quality Assurance (QA) personnel were interviewed and procedures were reviewed to determine whether adequate interface controls are in place to control nonconforming items. Nonconformances in the future will be initiated in accordance with Yucca Mountain Site Characterization Project Procedure (YAP)-15.1Q, Control of Nonconforming Items; therefore, identified procedural inadequacies have been addressed. A review of personnel assignments was conducted to determine if cognizant personnel are being trained to YAP-15.1Q. REECo memorandum dated February 4, 1994, Straub to Distribution, contains a request that management review the training assignments for personnel who were trained to REECo procedure MC-11.2, Nonconformance Control, to determine which staff members will be required to train to YAP-15.1Q. REECo training records list 82 personnel trained to MC-11.2 and 25 personnel trained to YAP-15.1Q as of today's date. RSN has requested that 22 cognizant employees be trained to YAP-15.1Q, and a list is being maintained and checked off as training is completed.

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¹⁰SURVEILLANCE CONCLUSIONS:

(1) It was verified that nonconforming gauge PTL No. W5765 is being controlled. A hold tag is still attached to the calibrated item and the item is not in use. Furthermore, the system from which the hold tag and gauge was removed is not being used at present.

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(2) It was determined that procedure YMP-15.1Q includes adequate interface controls for nonconforming items. Since employees designated by management as requiring training to YAP-15.1Q may not all be trained as of this date, it is suggested that follow-up be made by REECo and RSN training personnel to assure that cognizant staff is trained to the procedure.
