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Dear Mr. Zinke:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is revising its guidance with respect to the need to evaluate alternative energy sources in an early site permit application (ESP). The Commission has determined, and will clarify, that an ESP applicant need not include an assessment of alternative energy sources in its environmental report. For example, the NRC's position will be articulated in the upcoming proposed rulemaking on *Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 52, expected to be published in the *Federal Register* later this summer. We want to inform you of this development so that you can make an informed decision as to whether to include consideration of alternate energy sources in Entergy Nuclear's application for an ESP at the Grand Gulf site.
