1. The biggest concern for us is receiving information about Surelite sealed sources. Surelite sources have been authorized for use on other SSD certificates (MD-177-D-801/802-G and CA-1140-D-101-G as well as the New York Certificates). These certificates acknowledge the fact that Surelite sources have not been SSD reviewed, but points out that they have been used for over 40yrs with out incident. I think we should just ask for the ANSI N43.4 classification if you think we need this additional information.
