Effective October 1, 1994, all quality-affecting activities performed by the Raytheon Services Nevada have been transitioned to other participating organizations. Raytheon Services Nevada no longer performs quality-affecting work for the Yucca Mountain Project and has retired its quality assurance program.

As a consequence, the Civilian Radioactive Waste Management Office of Quality Assurance will no longer perform compliance and assessment overview (i.e., audit/surveillance and annual performance evaluations) of Raytheon Services Nevada's quality assurance program, nor track information relative to this organization's quality assurance program compliance with upper tier requirements.
