RE-ACTIVATION OF THE REGISTRATION FOR THE MODEL NO. MAID N
DENSITY GAUGE (CASE 03-31, TAC L20891)

Dear Mr. Malvin:

This refers to your request dated April 8, 2003, for re-activation on an inactive registration for the Model No. MAID N density gauge (NR-462-D-803-B).

Based on your request to change source designation and the additions of variations of the gauge, we will need to process your request as an amendment, not a re-activation (see Section 13.5 of NUREG-1556, Volume 3, "Consolidated Guidance about Materials Licenses, Applications for Sealed Source and Device Evaluation and Registration").

In connection with our review of an amendment, we need to have a complete application, including a delineation of the proposed changes, in accordance with Chapter 10, "Contents of the Application and the Review Process", of NUREG-1556.

With incomplete documents and unavailability of adequate information, the NRC staff is unable to complete a safety evaluation of your devices. Therefore, we have discontinued the review of your application. This is without prejudice to re-submission of your application. If you decide to submit your application for registration, please ensure that you have included sufficient information to allow NRC to evaluate your devices.
