Concerning the dispersment of radioactive waste from nuclear weapons and nuclear power, I would like to make the following comments:

Report on and recapture all the nuclear wastes that have already deregulated over the years to truly see if no harm has come from it.

Focus of rulemaking on better ISOLATING nuclear waste from the public and the environment rather than dispersing it deliberately.

Prohibit the release of radioactive wastes and materials from nuclear power and weapons into the marketplace for unrestricted or conditional uses.

Prevent additional radiation exposures rather than justifying them with computer codes and dose modeling created by nuclear advocates. I oppose "dose-based" or "risk-bases" standards.

Since there is no safe dose of ionizing radiation, I accept no dose above naturally occurring background and voluntary exposures for our own personal benefit.

Stop poisoning us and the recycling industries with ANY level of radioactive contamination from nuclear power and weapons fuel chain activities.

This would seem to be a common sense issue. I guess the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission and others have lost their common sense.
