WASTE CONFIDENCE DECISION - RESPONSE TO COMMENTS

We have reviewed the Department of Energy (DOE) comment on the Waste Confidence Decision Review (54 FR 39767-39797) which addresses license renewal, page 1 of the enclosure to the DOE letter dated December 27, 1989. We suggest the following response.


"DOE observed that renewal of operating licenses would increase the total amount of spent fuel requiring disposal or interim storage which would be taken into account in DOE program planning and should be considered in NRC's National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documentations for license renewal. This is generally consistent with findings in 54 FR 39767-39797, especially page 39795. It was found that the greater amount of spent fuel which must be stored as a result of license renewal does not affect the Commission's findings of a lack of environmental impacts overall. In addition, each relicensing action would be subject to a NEPA review covering storage of spent fuel during the period of the renewal license."
