SUBJECT: DELAY IN IMPLEMENTING RECOMMENDATIONS: "NRC'S  
HANDLING AND MARKING OF SENSITIVE UNCLASSIFIED  
INFORMATION" (OIG-03-4-01)

In our memorandum of May 14, 2003, concerning the status of recommendations resulting from OIG-03-4-01, we advised you that we expected to complete the initial round of security training for all employees by June 30, 2003.

While we still expect a significant percentage of NRC employees to be trained by that date, limited seating availability of the TWFN auditorium has made it impossible for all employees to be briefed by then. NRR, for example, cannot send all its staff during the June dates and has requested that we provide several training sessions in July. Therefore, we have added briefing sessions in July 2003 to accommodate NRR and other NRC staff who were not able to attend a session in June.
